**Pope Francis' July Prayer Intention:**

*For the elderly – We pray for the elderly, who represent the roots and memory of a people; their experience and wisdom help young people to look towards the future with hope and responsibility.*

From today's Reading

**Gen 18:20-32/ Col 2:12-14/ Lk 11:1-13**

Prayer forms the subject of the First Reading and the Gospel. Prayer is a favourite theme of Luke. In the First Reading we see Abraham interceding with God on behalf of Sodom, a city full of evil. Troubled by the idea of the innocent being punished along with the guilty, he begins to bargain with God. The story highlights the importance of intercessory prayer, and reveals a lot about the mercy of God.

This prepares us for the Gospel which shows Jesus at prayer and contains the Lord's Prayer. Luke's version is shorter than Matthew's, which is believed to be closer to the original version. Jesus urges the disciples to go on asking for what they need with persistence and confidence.
