Prayer Intention:

For migrants fleeing their homes

We pray that migrants fleeing from war or hunger, forced to undertake journeys full of danger and violence, find welcome and new opportunities in the countries that receive them.

Job 38:1-4,8-11++/ 2Corinthians 5:14-17/ Mark 4:35-41

In 4:35-43 Mark follows the section on the parables with four miraculous actions of Jesus. The first of these was the calming of the storm.

In the Bible the calming of a storm is a characteristic sign of divine power, because the sea and the wind are seen as forces of evil and chaos which only God can control. But the storm can also stand for the trials and tribulations which the righteous suffer, and from which only the power of God can save them.

In the calming of the storm, the apostles witnessed a work that only God can accomplish, which means that Jesus has divine power. At the same time the miracle shows Jesus' care for his apostles. Mark is using the story for catechetical purposes. The storm reflects the post- Easter experience of the early Church. The disciples have run into all sorts of difficulties, and feel that the Lord has abandoned them. But they are summoned to have faith in his presence with them and care for them.

Upcoming CPE unit in Regina

The Spiritual Care department of Santa Maria Senior Citizens Home, Regina, will be offering Clinical Psycho Spiritual Education (CPE) from **September 2024 to March 2025**. CPE helps to form and develop one’s self for service, which is our primary tool in caring for others. If you are interested in developing your skills in soul-care, whether for professional development, seminary credit, or as a way to develop your personalized learning goals, CPE is a formational learning opportunity. An internationally recognized program, CPE teaches skills and competencies for professional spiritual care and can lead to certification with Canadian Association of Spiritual Care (CASC/ACSS).

Students gather with a small peer group for a full day on Tuesdays and spiritual care clinical practice opportunities will take place one day per week at Santa Maria + students' current ministry sites. Group and individual supervision will be provided by Erika Mills, CASC Certified Supervisor-Educator.

CPE accepts up to 6 students per learning site. Tuition is \$1350 plus required student membership and insurance with CASC/ACSS, approximately \$200. **Applications are due July 1, 2024**. Further information and application forms are available at cpe-saskatoon.com.
