 Prayer Intention:
That the world might grow in compassion
Let us pray that each one of us might find consolation in a personal relationship with Jesus, and from his Heart, learn to have compassion on the world.

From the readings:

It biblical times it was common for wisdom to be personified. The reading from Proverbs looks to the role of Lady Wisdom in creation. This speculation about wisdom can be seen as a grouping towards the revelation of the mystery of the Trinity. The Second Reading and the Gospel are chosen because they specifically mention the three Persons of the Blessed Trinity, an date role of each Person in our salvation.

Paul stresses the role of Christ in our salvation. Through him hostility and alienation are overcome, and we are able to enter into relationship with the Father. Therefore, we can hope to share God’s glory. This sure hope will enable us to persevere in spite of suffering. Through the Holy Spirit God’s love is poured into our hearts.

The Gospel stresses the role of the Spirit — carrying on in the Church the work of Jesus after Jesus has departed to the Father. There will be no new revelation. There can’t be, because Jesus is the revelation of the Father. The role of the Spirit will be to spell out to successive generations the contemporary significance of what Jesus said and did.

Parish Scam Alert: Fraudulent Information Requests

We’ve been made aware of a scam currently targeting parishes in which an individual sends an email pretending to be someone known to the parish office (e.g., a staff member, priest, or volunteer). The email may request a copy of the parish directory or other lists in order to access personal contact information.

Important Warning Signs:

The email comes from an address that does not match the official address of the person named. The message may have urgent or vague language asking for help or access to data.

What to Do:

Do not respond or provide any information. Double-check the email address carefully—scammers often use similar-looking domains. Report the email to your parish office and your IT support or diocesan communications office. Do not click any links or download attachments from suspicious emails. Protecting the privacy of our parishioners is critical. Thank you for staying alert and helping keep our communities safe!
