The Nicene Creed stands as one of Christianity's most influential theological statements. But what has been its impact on Jewish-Christian relations, dialogue, and understanding? In this anniversary year, what opportunities exist for deeper theological engagement between our traditions?

This webinar explores these questions through multiple scholarly perspectives. Rather than rehashing historical grievances, this conversation seeks substantive theological engagement about the experience of divine presence, covenantal identity, and the interpretation of shared scriptural traditions. Both communities will explore how their respective developments have shaped — and been shaped by — this pivotal moment in Christian history.
