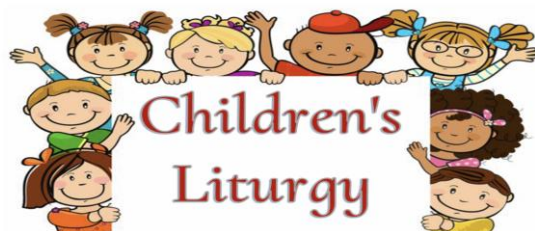
IS PRE-AUTHORIZED DONATIONS (PAD) AN OPTION FOR YOU?
