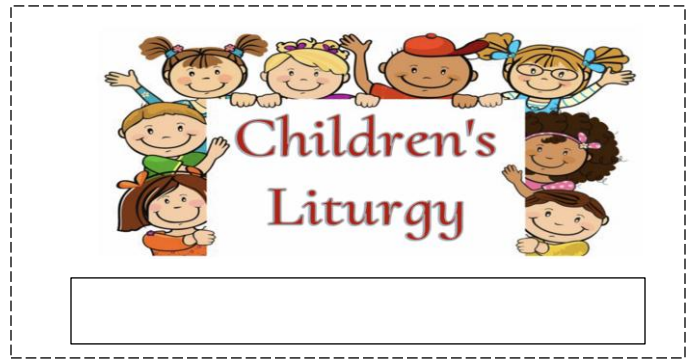
Registration for catechism classes for the **Sacraments of Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation** are now being accepted for children aged 7 or higher.

Spring Campaign Bulletin Reflection – In this Sunday’s Gospel, Jesus Christ looks out at the crowds and is moved with compassion. He sees people who are “harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.” His response is not distant concern, but action. First, He calls His disciples. Then, He sends them. The calling of the Twelve Apostles reminds us that God’s work in the world is carried out through ordinary people. They are not chosen because they are perfect or fully prepared, but because they are willing to follow. Jesus then entrusts them with His mission: to proclaim the Good News, to heal, to bring hope, and to serve. “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few.” These words still speak to us today. The need is great and the call continues.
