**Bulletin Reflection** - In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus Christ speaks with striking clarity about the cost of discipleship. Following Him is not one commitment among many others, but the foundation that gives meaning to all the rest.

These words challenge us because they call for reordered priorities. Jesus is not asking us to stop loving family or to abandon responsibilities.

He is asking that our love be rooted first in Him so that every other relationship may be rightly ordered and transformed.

The Gospel then turns to something deeply encouraging. Even the smallest act done in His name carries great value.

*Registrations are open for the 8th annual Saint Philomena Walking Pilgrimage.*

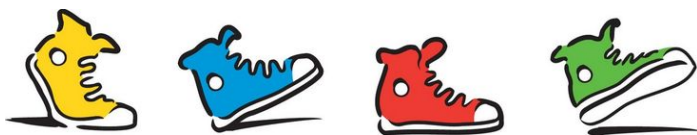
- A physical and spiritual journey with daily Mass or Divine Liturgy and prayer!
