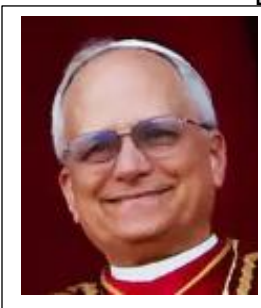

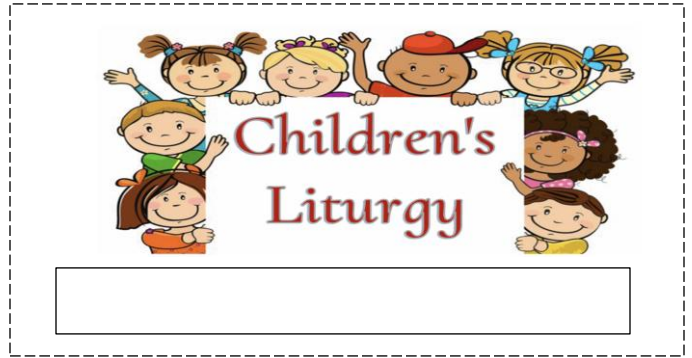

The Regina chapter of the Royal Canadian College of Organists invites you to our first ever year-end pipe organ recital. Eight organists (members of RCCO Regina and their students) are teaming up to show each other (and the public) some pieces they've been working on this year. The list of pieces (which I just collected yesterday) includes Bach, Widor, Dupre, Rheinberger, Bedard, ... and 3 movie themes. (June 9 is the birthday of Johnny Depp.)

This event serves as an opportunity for more performance experience for developing organists. It also is a chance to celebrate organ, local organists, and this fabulous organ at Holy Rosary.

Admission is by voluntary cash donation; money goes to both RCCO Regina and the Holy Rosary organ fund (some new front pipes with a golden hue were installed last week).
